

BYPASS DOOR Installation Instructions For Up to 60 LBS. Door Weight






Contents: (Screw Quantities may differ depending on the size of track) • 4 (2) Finger Pulls

- (1) Sliding Door Track
- 4 (4) Adjustable Door Hangers 5 #8 x 1½" Sheet Metal ZP Screws • 6 #8 x 5%" Sheet Metal ZP Screws
- 2 x Wheel 1/2" Offset
- 7 #8 x 5%" Sheet Metal Brass Screws
- (1) Adjustable Floor Guide
- 3 #8 x 1 ½" Sheet Metal Brass Screws.

Step 1

Measure width and height of finished opening and record it.



Step 2


Preparing Doors:

Door width is 1/2 the size of finished opening plus 1/2" per panel. Example: Opening width of 48", each door panel must be 24½" wide. Door height should be 1¾" less than the finished opening height (measured from top of opening to finished floor or top of carpeting).




Step 3


Cut galvanized steel track length to at least 1/8" less than the width of the finished opening by using fine tooth blade hacksaw.



Step 4

Secure the track as illustrated below with fasteners provided and centered between jambs. Use track as a template and mark screw hole locations. Drill 7/64" pilot holes to approximate length of screws





Step 5


Mount Hangers:

- Place Hanger on the back/top door panels using screws provided.
- Hangers should be 1½" from side of door.
- Use hanger as a template to mark screw hole locations
- Drill 7/64" pilot holes to approximate length of screws.
- * Make sure to install matching hangers on each door panel.

Step 6

Hang Doors on Track

- Hang rear door first by tilting door back and resting hangers on rear rail.
- Repeat for the front door panel on front rail.



Step 7


Adjusting the Hangers

- To adjust and align doors with jambs, lift door at side near jamb to remove weight of door from hanger.
- Loosen screws and using a slotted screwdriver in the bottom slot, adjust left (raise) or right (lower) for proper alignment.
- Tighten screws.

Step 8

Install Floor Guide:


- Remove two end guides
- Secure center guide in the center of the opening on the floor with screws provided.
- Insert two end guides to center guide, making sure the space between two guides fits the door thickness.
- Fasten the end guides with screws provided.



Step 9


Install Finger Pulls:

- Drill a 3/4" hole with 3/8" deep, approximate 40" from the floor and 1-1/2" from the edge on the door panel.
- Depress the pull to the hole.



Step 10

If baseboard on the sides of the door opening prevents proper closing, remove the baseboard as needed.
